Learning is an active and not a passive activity. Learning processes in this toolkit include writing activities, discussion or debate, creative activities e.g. art or drama and physical movement through activities like sport and physical education.

At the end of each lesson, there is an opportunity for pupils to produce a piece of work based on what they have learned during their lesson.

Chance for pupils to win a place at the LEAP Summer Camp in 2012 – ages 12-16

The LEAP Summer Camp will be a once in a lifetime opportunity for young people to learn about Olympic Values and experience the Olympic Games in London. In a five day, all expenses paid residential summer camp from 27 July to 3 August which is during the London 2012 Olympic Games, up to 50 young people will have the chance to learn from Olympic athletes, visit historical and cultural sites in London and take in some of the sporting action.

GSD is offering up to 30 places at the LEAP Summer Camp to the young people who produce the best art work after learning about Olympic Values at school. Class teachers should submit entries by e-mail or post. Parents should submit entries by e-mail.

The LEAP Summer Camp competition is open to young people aged 12-16 who are in school years 8 to 12 in the London Boroughs. The closing date is 11 November 2011. Age will be taken into account.

Win London 2012 Olympic / Paralympic tickets – ages 10-11 only

Children at school in the London Boroughs in school years 6 and 7 (ages 10-11) who produce the best art work after learning about Olympic Values at school can win a pair of tickets for them and a parent/carer to an Olympic or Paralympic event. GSD is offering 20 pairs of tickets to selected Olympic and Paralympic events.

Class teachers should submit entries by e-mail or post with an accompanying form. See entry form for details. Parents can also submit entries by e-mail.

The closing date is 11 November 2011. Age will be taken into account.
